

MEET MY E-MOTIONS:

Ryangry: Frustrated, angry, “bossy”, assertive, loud, determined. In this set, Ryangry represents feeling very angry! Children can use Ryangry to express emotions around that scope and you can teach them different emotion names such as: upset, frustrated, etc..



Dramamia: excited, happy, smiling, laughing, giggling, “dramatic”, fun. In this set, Dramamia represents feeling very happy! You can discuss emotions like: excited, surprised, love, etc...



Pleasington: soft voice, self-pity, friendly, loving, empathetic, whiny, worried. In this set, Pleasington represents feeling worried! You can discuss emotions like: empathetic, worried, concerned, etc...



Perfectron: sharp voice, accurate, blunt, justice seeker, perfectionist, serious. In this set, Perfectron represents feeling heartbroken! You can discuss emotions like: grief, sadness, not letting go, etc...



Fearolina: shy/reserved, fearful, strong will power, blends in easily, quiet, mellow. In this set, Fearolina represents feeling scared! You can discuss emotions like: fear, anxiety, etc...
