



“GAMIFYING” (ADDING COMPETITION TO) “LET’S SHARE”

DO IT WITH STYLE

Ryangry: Frustrated, angry, “bossy”, assertive, loud, determined



Dramamia: excited, happy, smiling, laughing, giggling, “dramatic”, fun



Pleasington: soft voice, self-pity, friendly, loving, empathetic, whiny, worried



Perfectron: sharp voice, accurate, blunt, justice seeker, perfectionist, serious



Fearolina: shy/reserved, fearful, strong will power, blends in easily, quiet, mellow



The first player takes a card and follows the instructions. Once that is done, look at the list below and all the players (including the first one) have to follow the instructions but this time it has to be in the “style” mentioned in the list (“Dramamia style”, “Ryangry style”, etc...).

At the end of each round, all the players need to vote who was the best at acting out the character. For example, if the style was “Dramamia” and the character just burnt their muffins, whoever is the most dramatic would win.



On the “Styles” section you can find some traits of each character so you can get ideas how the character might react. This is an opportunity to discuss these with your child.
